Extension work for the new Year 4 classroom and cooking room has been agreed. The governors are currently working with the contractor to finalise all the details before the building project starts. The new Year 4 classroom will enable the expansion of the Nursery and Afterschool club into one of the current Year 4 classrooms.

We are currently preparing for the School Summer Fayre however a change of date and time has been made due to unforeseen circumstances. The new date and time for the Summer Fayre will be on Friday 28 June from 3.00—5.00 p.m.
