REMINDER - Parent Workshops from CAMHS

Our colleagues in the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) have produced a series of <u>pre-recorded webinars</u> for parents and carers. The topics cover a range of difficulties that young people may be experiencing.

Each workshop gives an overview of a specific difficulty and also some hints and tips on how young people can be supported. There are also links to some resources that you may find helpful, either while you are waiting for CAMHS treatment, or as an alternative to CAMHS.



We believe that all parents, carers and trusted adults should be empowered with all the information needed to have informed and age-appropriate conversations about online safety and global issues with children.

Each Wednesday, National Online Safety produce practical, easy to follow guides which focus on specific risks that we think you need to be aware of from new websites and platforms to issues such as mental health, wellbeing and climate change. It is called **Wake Up Wednesday**.


