Leechpool Music Gala



We would like to invite all families to the Leechpool Music Gala on Thursday 17 July from 5.00—7.00 p.m. Performance starts at 5.15 p.m. Entrance is by donation and all donations will go towards the on-going improvement of the music provision at Leechpool. Throughout the children's time at the school all children get the chance to learn 6 different types of instruments as part of our music provision.

In addition children have chances to be part of different choirs that have been established and this enables the children to share their many talents at events within the Horsham Community.

We do hope you will all come along and see the children preform a range of musical pieces that they have been working on over the last academic year. Information about the evening will be sent on a separate letter.

School Meals

Children moving on from Year 2 to Year 3 will no longer be entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals. If your child is not entitled to pupil premium free school meals, meals will now need to paid for via Parentpay. Your account will remain the same, however where there was previously a zero balance, this will show as a cost that needs to be settled before the cut off date of 2 weeks. The current cost of a meal is £3.09.

For all children having a hot meal, please ensure that you order in advance i.e. before the cut off date. This is especially important before the start of the autumn term. Please see the previous email sent with details of cut off dates for the next academic year.

New Foundation Stage children will shortly be sent a letter from Parentpay with details on how to set up their account and order lunches.

Healthy Snacks



Please can all families ensure that they send their children in with a healthy snack and a bottle of water each day. Ideas for morning snacks—fruit, cheese, cucumber, carrots, popcorn. **No chocolate or crisps please**.

Could we please remind all families that children should attend school with a slim water bottle, hat and sunscreen cream already applied on hot sunny days.
