SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

- A high standard of personal appearance is expected of all pupils at Leechpool Primary School.
- To assist families, we have offered a style of uniform which all children can comfortably wear.
- NO fashion items, including frills, fancy trims or non-school logos.
- Children are responsible for their uniform. All items must be named. Any items brought in to school during the school day, must be in a named bag. A lost property box is located on the playground.

The Governing Body encourages the wearing of uniform for the following reasons:

- It helps to foster positive attitudes and high standards.
- It helps our pupils identify and develop a sense of belonging to the whole school community.
- All children are seen as equal, regardless of financial circumstances.
- From a security aspect, it enables staff to readily recognise OUR pupils.
- It assures both families and teaching staff that the child is wearing clothes that are suitable for work in the school, thus removing any potential problems that changes in fashion could bring about.
- It encourages every child to take pride in his/her appearance and in Leechpool Primary School.
- It enables the local community of Roffey and Horsham to readily identify and associate with our school.

With the safety and well-being of your children sharply in focus, it is anticipated that all parents will support this *policy*.

PE Kit

Children in **EYFS only** should bring their PE kit to school on a Monday in a small PE bag which has the child's name on it. PE Kits should be kept in school all week and taken home for washing on Fridays. **Children in Years 1/2/3/4/5/6** should come to school on their allocated PE days wearing their PE kit. They will remain in their kit all day.

Naming Items

Every item of clothing should be clearly named so we can return lost property to its owner as soon as possible.

Hair

1) For safety reasons, all long hair needs to be drawn back from the face and tightly secured (e.g. by hair bands).

2) No extreme fashion hairstyles are acceptable i.e. Mohicans, sculpted patterns, tramlines or shaved heads etc. If you are unsure – please seek advice before cutting or styling your child's hair.

3) Ribbons, clips, headscarves etc. should be kept simple and to school colours. Braiding and coloured beads are best kept for school holidays.

Swimming

Our Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 children are offered the opportunity to attend swimming sessions and will require their own swimming trunks (tight fitting, **not** boxer shorts) or a one-piece costume, with a towel and a swimming hat (both boys and girls). **NO** jewellery of any kind may be worn during swimming sessions.

Jewellery/Nail Varnish

With the exception of a plain gold/silver stud in each ear lobe and an inexpensive wristwatch without alarms, **jewellery is not allowed**. Sparkly earrings may not be worn at school.

Ear studs and watches **must** be removed for all PE activities. This includes sleepers and studs in newly pierced ears. Staff are not

responsible for the removal or replacement of earrings. Pupils may not wear nail varnish at school.

School Bags

For health and safety reasons, pupils are not permitted to bring large bags, sports holdalls or other bulky containers into the school. All clothing for PE and swimming activities should be put in named draw-stringed bags or named carrier bags.
